We take this experience as an opportunity to share with others the adventure of traveling and seeing the world while enjoying it with our camping family and friends.

As Vice President, I happily welcome you and your family to the Triangle RV Family. Enclosed you will find information about our club, its history, and its connection to National African American Recreation Vehicle Association (NAARVA), and it is the nation's first chartered RV association for minorities in the United States. NAARVA consists of thousands of members from four regions of the US (Central, Southern, Eastern, and Western), and our club is a part of the Eastern Region. To attend a NAARVA event, such as the national rally, you must be a member of NAARVA. NAARVA membership fees must be paid prior to attending the NAARVA National Rallies. Also, if you desire to become an officer in the Triangle RVers, you must be a member of NAARVA. NAARVA membership fees are \$50.00 Annually or \$135.00 for 3 YEARS. The NAARVA membership fees are expected to be paid at *naarva.com*. The mailing address for NAARVA is NAARVA National Headquarters, INC., 961 Roberts Branch Pkwy, Ste 106-240, Columbia SC 29203.

Our Triangle RV Club annual membership fees are \$65 a year, and \$10 of this goes to the Eastern Region for your annual Eastern Region membership fees. Our club membership fees are due by January 15 of each calendar year.
